

Front Installation

1F Raise Front

Securely chock the rear wheels and raise the front of the vehicle so the wheels are off the ground.





3F Detach ABS Clamp

There is an ABS plastic clamp that holds the ABS line in place. It is located on top of the shock shaft threads. Unclip the ABS line from the clamp and pull up on the clamp to remove it from the shock shaft.





5F Disconnect the Lower Shock Mount Under the lower control arm you will find the lower shock mount. Undo the (2) nuts and drop the shock down and remove.




6F Clearance Shock Opening

Since the Hotchkis shock is an upgraded heavy duty shock, the body is larger than conventional dampers. This will require the shock opening on the control arm to be clearanced to allow the larger shock to pass through.

seas soferish Average springs shown below. You are basically opening up the circular hole section 1/8" all around. Try not to grind too close to the stud sections. The shock body cap that needs to pass through is Ø2.6" so the opening will need to be slightly larger than this dimension.



Use a barrel sander or similar to open up the hole. Paint the exposed edge with black paint.



7F Remove the OE Shock Studs


Use a hammer to pop out the OE studs that are in the lower control arm. This will leave (2) lower mounting holes.





8F Install the Hotchkis Shock

You will notice there are (2) machined flat spots on the Hotchkis shock body cap. These are needed to clear the area of the opening that supports the lower shock mounting holes. See diagram.



Before you insert the shock into the opening, you will need to compress the shock to make it as short as possible. There is some preload but the shaft should extend very slowly which will buy you some time to get it in the opening.


Make sure the bushing retainer and bottom bushing are installed on the shaft prior to inserting the shock through the opening.





Guide the shaft to line up with the top shock hole.

Once in place, install the included (5/16" x 1") bolt and washer through each shock mount hole. Have the bolts pointing down.



Line up the t-bar mount to the bolts and install the other washer and nylock nut to each bolt. Fully Tighten these fasteners.





From the top, Install the remaining bushing, retainer and lock nut onto the shock shaft. Tighten until the bushings just begin to bulge. Do not over tighten.



Reinstall the ABS clamp, ABS line, and wheel. Lower the truck and you are done with the front.

The product has to be unused and in its original packaging materials. Exchanges or refunds made after 30 days will be subject to a 20% restocking charge. If you purchased your Hotchkis Performance product from an authorized dealer, you are still covered by this return policy. All returns however, should be made to your dealer, not to Hotchkis Performance directly.

Limited Warranty

Hotchkis Performance offers a Limited Warranty against defects in materials and workmanship for the term of 36 months (3 years) from the date of purchase of this product. This Warranty only applies to the original retail purchaser who retains ownership of the vehicle on which the product was originally installed. If the product is determined to be defective, Hotchkis Performance will repair, replace or refund the purchase price of the defective product at Hotchkis Performance's sole discretion, which shall fully satisfy and discharge any and all warranty claims. Any repaired or replaced product will be returned to the sender excluding the cost of freight. Products must be registered to qualify for warranty at www.hotchkis.net or via the mail-in warranty card, included with the product, within 30 days of the original purchase date.
